Weston Park Primary 4th-8th September 2017


It was very fun and caving was my favourite. It was fun working as a team and doing stuff on my own. And I like the story teller that came in and told us a story about a green man. Oscar


I really liked caving and being duty table. Iolanda

In Pendarren I have learned that we could work together to solve problems that we cant solve alone. *Kushie*


I love this place and it has tought me a lot. I wish I can come back to Pendarren. Ayoub

Risley Avenue Primary 9th-13th October 2017



At Pendarren I found out I could do things that seemed like too much for a single kid and I did things I thought I would never do. *Matt*


Experienced things I've never done before and it was amazing so I give Pendarren a million stars. *Mustafa*

I am feeling great because I learned how to take care of myself. You should come to Pendarren because it has things you can not imagine, things you will never have tryed. *Liliana*


Stroud Green Primary 20th-24th November 2017
